Minutes for October 15, 2007

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

1. Minutes from the last meeting were read. Elvin Robertson motioned to accept and Carl Rainey provided a second.
2. Diamond Jim discussed the recent ride to the Pro Football Hall of Fame. While only 2 TCMC riders participated, there were a total of 13 riders and the round trip was approximately 275 miles. Everyone enjoyed the ride and the Hall of Fame visit.
3. Mike Chionchio discussed this Sunday's ride to Cumberland. Ride will depart from Sheetz (near Bill's Golfland) promptly at 9:00 am. Also reminder to purchase train tickets in advance.
4. Elvin discussed the recent Gary Freeland ride. There were 90 bikes and it was expected that they raised approximately \$2,000.
5. Debbie Munshower provided a treasury report as follows: Cash received from Anita Robertson (previous treasurer) and deposited: \$1,062.74. Current Expenditures: \$40.00 for purchase of 2 Fire Dept Cash Bash tickets. Current balance \$1,012.74. Jim Diamond made a motion to accept the report and Larry Guess provided a second.
6. There was a lengthy discussion on nominations for club officers and board members for 2008. We need nominations for President, Vice President, three board members, ride captain and alternate. An email will be sent to all members with a nomination form. It is requested that any nominations made be verified with the nominee to insure that this person or persons are willing to accept the position, if elected. 7. Discussions held as to what we want to do for this years Christmas celebration. It was decided, by all members in attendance, that we would have a buffet breakfast/lunch. Diamond Jim will check on the availability of the Blue Flame restaurant on Rt. 51 Pleasant Hills. Possible dates are the 8th or 15th of December. It was also decided that each member and 1 guest will be requested to pay \$5.00 each, in advance with the club picking up the balance of the meals. Any guests beyond 1 would be the responsibility of the member. Also, each attendee is asked to bring a gift with a minimal value of \$15.00. Male brings a male or non gender gift and females likewise. The motion to accept this plan was made by Diamond Jim with a second from Joe Campo. Carol Bobby made a motion for the club to purchase \$100 worth of gift cards (5-\$20 or 4-\$25) to be given as door prizes. Carl Rainey made a second and all members in attendance voted to accept.
