Minutes for July 16, 2007

Meeting called to order at 7:15 PM

1. Minutes for last months meeting were read and accepted.
2. Elvin discussed the recent Toys for Tots ride which was disappointing based upon a misunderstanding or lack of information concerning costs. Also the TCMC was not treated well at the after ride festivities and were basically told that they did not want TCMC to set up a collection table for them. Most members left without attending the event.
3. There was a brief discussion on the Camp Cadet ride. Everyone seemed to enjoy the event and TCMC came home with 2 trophies for best in show.
4. Tuesday 7/31 @ 6:00pm Baldwin Boro parade. Meet at Eat-N-Park located at Rt.51 and Streets Run Road for a 6:30 departure. Parade lasts about 90 minutes and riders will receive a free dinner.

6. Rich Hogya provided information about the Ride for Jesus to be held on August 4th. Meet at County Airport Police Station @ 9am for a free breakfast. Parade starts at 10am and lasts about 1 hour.
7. Per Elvin the August 11th TC Barbecue will most likely be cancelled. TCMC has not been very accommodating with the barbecues this year. August 11 is also our road cleanup date.
8. The 9/11 ride is on August 17-18-19. 8 are currently signed up to go.
9. August 26th is the annual Frank's Shoes ride.
10. John Munshower will lead a ride on Saturday 7/21 to Blackwater Falls West Virginia. Remember that helmets are required. Ride will be an all day event and pull out from Sheetz at 9am.
11. No nominations were received for the positions of club president, treasurer, or ride coordinator. Richard Hogya volunteered to assume the position of President, Debbie Munshower, Treasurer, and Larry Guess will continue as Secretary. With Richards' move from vice-president to president, the vice-president's position is currently vacant. This position will likely be filled within the next 3 or 4 months. As there were no formal nominations for these vacancies from the membership, there will not be a formal voting period. Carl Rainey made a motion for a verbal
